Balearic Islands

The Balearic Islands stand out for the wines production and export with protected designation of origin and geographical indications, cheese, almonds, oil, honey and typical local products like sobrassada (meat) and ensaimada (dessert).

In Crete the extensive cultivation of olive trees stands out, which translates into a large production and export of oil, mostly extra virgin, and olives. The region also produces two PGI wines and PDO cheeses.



Sardinia

Italy

Sheep milk cheese and wine represent the most known and exported food products of Sardinia Island. There are 45 geographical indications including 33 PDO and PGI wines, 3 PDO cheeses. There are also traditional products like honey, bread, jam and pasta.
